Please see the suggested activities below for you to complete with your child at your leisure. Children are welcome to bring in completed homework at any time to share with the class.

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Draw a body outline or draw around your own body and label all the body parts that you can.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>Find out something interesting about the history of our local area. You could present this as videos, posters, photos, a fact page.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you create your own fact family number sentences? e.g.</p> $5+3=8 \quad 8=3+5$ $3+5=8 \quad 8=5+3$ $8-5=3 \quad 8-3=5$ $5=8-3 \quad 3=8-5$	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Handwriting</u></p> <p>Using the handwriting paper provided, practise writing sentences or lists carefully on the handwriting lines. For example, you could write a sentence about something you have done that day. You could also practise writing individual letters on the paper.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite book character and write a sentence to explain who the character is and why it is your favourite character. Could you also use an adjective to describe that character?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of yourself and another family member. Discuss the similarities and differences between you. This could be how you look and what your likes and dislikes are. Additionally, you could record this as labels for the pictures or sentences.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Choose a song you like. Talk about how that song makes you feel. Can you identify the instruments in that piece of music? Can you clap along to the beat?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Make a poster to show what Christmas means to you. You could draw a picture of the Nativity or special things you do for Christmas and then write about it.</p>
