Reception Learning Objectives

Autumn Term w/b 23rd September

This week in school we will be learning...

English — To be able to label objects with initial sounds. We will also be learning the nursery rhyme 'Round and round the garden' and coming up with some rhyming words.

Phonics - (Please see sheet below.)

<u>Maths</u> — to explore how all sorts of things can be counted, including sounds. Singing counting rhymes will give them opportunities to hear, join in with and develop their knowledge of the counting sequence.

<u>Understanding of the World</u> — To talk about where we live and how we travel to school. We will be looking at maps to explore our local community.

Over the next two weeks in school we will be learning...

<u>Communication and Language</u> — To be able to listen to others one to one or in a small group and respond appropriately.

Physical Development — To learn how to use the sports equipment safely and appropriately.

<u>PSED</u> — To continue to talk about the Zones of Regulation. We will be having discussions around expected and unexpected behaviours at different parts of the day.

Expressive Arts and Design — To draw maps of the local community.

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - g

Give me a big smile that shows your teeth. Press the middle of your tongue to the top and back of your mouth; push your tongue down and forward to make the sound **ggg**



Pronunciation Phrase - o

Make your mouth into a round shape and say ooo



Pronunciation Phrase - c

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say ccc



Pronunciation Phrase - k

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say kkk

We will be orally blending words. Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?

We will be practising tricky words. Can you spot the tricky part of the word?

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
