

Reception Learning Objectives

Autumn Term w/b 20th October

This week in school we will be learning...

English – We will be continuing to re-tell 'The Little Red Hen'. We will be creating different and labelling pictures from the story using initial sounds and CVC words.

Phonics – We will be carrying out Phonics assessments.

Maths – To describe sets of objects that they can see using the language of 'more than' and 'fewer than'. 'Fewer than' is used rather than 'less than' because the focus is on countable things.

Understanding of the World – To explore how the place where we live changes throughout the year as the seasons change. We will be looking at deciduous and evergreen trees.

Over the next two weeks in school we will be learning...

Communication and Language – To respond to multi-step instructions e.g. first we need to put our coats on, then we need to zip them up, then we will get ready to go out to play.

Physical Development – To practise correct letter formation for the letters 'c' and 'a'.

PSED – To be able to turn take during a small group activity or game.

Expressive Arts and Design – To create pictures using different shapes and colours. We will be looking at which shapes and colours you would need for different parts of a picture linking this to emergency vehicles.
