Reception Learning Objectives

Autumn Term week 3

This week in school we will be learning...

English — to label a picture. We will begin to look at writing words and captions to describe a picture. Some children may begin to use adjectives to describe what they can see.

Phonics — (Please see sheet below.)

 ${\it Maths}$ — This week, the children will begin to explore composition by focusing on the preliminary skills: the concept of 'wholes' and 'parts'. By investigating their own bodies and familiar toys they will begin to understand that whole things are often made up of smaller parts and that a whole is, therefore, bigger than its parts.

<u>Understanding of the World</u> — To compare transport that we used in the past to transport used in present day. We will continue to learn about the similarities and differences between these and start to think about why.

Over the next two weeks in school, we will be learning.

Communication and Language — to be able to listen and re-tell a story. The children will begin learning their Nativity story map and will be internalising the language from this.

Physical Development — to dance to music, moving with control around the floor. We will be exploring beats and rhythm.

PSED — to understand different emotions and how they make us feel.

Expressive Arts and Design — to use different shapes to create pictures. We will be looking at creating pictures of transport and which shapes we might use for the different parts.

Notes

This half term our topic is 'Transport' which will include learning about how it has changed over time. If any parent has a job linking to this and would be happy to come in and share this with the children, please let your class teacher know to arrange a date and time.

We will also continue to learn about people who help us. If any parent works within the community e.g. police officer, nurse, vet and would come in to talk to the children about their job, please contact your child's class teacher.
