

Reception Learning Objectives

Spring Term w/b 18th March

This week in school we will be learning...

English – to write instructions. We will be learning vocabulary such as first, then, next, finally to help us when writing instructions.

Phonics – We will be carrying out our phonics assessments this week.

Maths – to consolidate their understanding of the composition of numbers by investigating the numbers within 7. Composing and de-composing numbers involves the children investigating part-part-whole relations, e.g. seeing that 7 can be made of 5 and 2. We will begin to recognise that numbers can be made by combining parts in different ways, and the children will be encouraged to make links by considering similarities and differences in the various ways of making 7.

Understanding of the World – to understand the different stages of metamorphosis. We will be looking at different lifecycles of living things to understand the process.

Over the next two weeks in school, we will be learning...

Communication and Language – to use newly acquired vocabulary to name and describe, and in conversations e.g. children can discuss their plants, how they cared for them and what they noticed.

Physical Development – to practise balance and co-ordination.

PSED – to develop independence. We will be looking at how we can help ourselves and resources we could use before asking for help from others.

Expressive Arts and Design – to use different materials and tools to create crafts. We will be beginning our Easter crafts and looking at suitable materials for each.

This half term our topic is 'Growing and Changing'. If any parents have any books or learning resources linked to this topic, then please let us know.

We will also be learning about Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday, Lent, Easter and Ramadan. If any parent would like to come in to talk to the children about any of these celebrations, please contact your child's class teacher.
