This week in school we will be learning...

Maths - To count in 1s from any given number to 100. To partition into 10s and 1s. To identify one more and one less. To compare numbers with the same number of 10s.

English - To use alliteration. To write a 'twist' in a story. To identify and use similes. To write own ending.

Foundation learning

Music - To listen, appraise and perform a song with instruments.

PSHE - To know how to look after a baby.

RE - To know that Aesop's Fables are a special type of story.

PE - To practice ball skills throwing with control. To practice for sports day!

History - To understand that King John I made an important promise to the people of England
