While your child is not in school tomorrow and Thursday, we have put together some suggestions for remote learning activities that they might like to complete.

RECEPTION

1. Reading books
2. Reading tricky words. Can you practise writing sentences with these tricky words in them?
3. Can you draw a picture and/or write a sentence about a living thing? This could be a plant, flower or animal. You could write what the living thing needs to survive. For example. The flower needs sun and water.

cow and calf **pig and piglet** **butterfly and caterpillar** **horse and foal** **duck and duckling** **hedgehog and hoglet**

people grow and change over time
past → present → future

plants need water and sunlight to grow

we can grow food to eat
carrots lettuce potatoes

KEY VOCABULARY

change	when something or someone becomes different over time
grow	when something or someone changes size
crops	plants that are grown for food
harvest	crops that are ready to be picked

this big machine is a combine harvester
farmers harvest crops from their fields

4. Can you collect 10 objects. Sort them into 2 groups. How many is in each group? How many is there altogether? How many different ways can you make 10?
5. Draw a picture of your favourite fruit or vegetable. Write a sentence explaining why. For example, I like apples because they are juicy.
6. Talk about the word 'metamorphosis'. How many different processes of this can you find? Discuss the different stages.
